The global geopolitical scenario has changed in the last years. Political, economic and social changes have traveled the world, without Spain or the Arab countries being an exception.


### **NEW STAGE**




### MISSION, VISION AND VALUES

### MISSION, VISION AND VALUES




### Vision





### CLIMATE CHANGE AND THE ECOLOGICAL TRANSITION

Climate change and the problems it causes are a global challenge of the highest level which connects spaces that reach above and beyond States. It affects trade, transportation, infrastructures, finance, the movement of people, ecosystems, geopolitics, security, and more.

Closely related with this, the ecological transition, the protection of natural heritage and biodiversity, water and tourism are a few topics of special interest. The fight to halt climate change, solutions to mitigate it and design measures to adapt are some of the main topics that Casa Árabe will be addressing.

### MIGRATORY PHENOMENA AND THEIR CONSEQUENCES

Migratory phenomena represent a major challenge for the EU, for Spain and, in particular, for Ceuta, Melilla and the Canary Islands. Casa Árabe's approach focuses on raising awareness about the situations which cause migrant flows and the realities experienced by migrants, both in their countries of origin and in Spain. We defend human rights, inclusiveness and diversity to build an open, tolerant society free of racism.





### **WOMEN AND EQUALITY**

The role, rights and realities experienced by women in the Arab world are disparate, multifaceted and sometimes similar to the reality of women in other regions in general, and to Spanish women in particular.

These priorities are aligned with the Substantive Lines of Action in Spain's Foreign Action Strategy for 2021-2024, with the Sustainable Development Goals in Agenda 2030 and with the Cairo Declaration for Arab Women and the Strategic Plan for the Empowerment of Women in the Arab Region - Development Agenda 2030 of the Arab League. The goal is to ensure the highest level of coherence between Casa Árabe's programming and that of its main consortium member, its international commitments and the interests of Spain and the Arab world alike.

# MAIN TOPICS HUMAN RIGHTS AND CITIZENSHIP

Protecting and promoting human rights forms part of the promotion of Spain's action abroad. The status, progress and furthering of human rights in the Arab world is another of the issues promoted by Casa Árabe and, in particular, the initiatives and activities which boost and consolidate democratization and a strengthening of the rule of Law.






### **ARAB CONTRIBUTION**
