Summer intensive Arabic courses for children and adults

In June and July, the Arabic Language Centre of Casa Árabe offers intensive and semi-intensive Arabic courses in modern standard Arabic, conversation, Moroccan *dariya* and Levantine dialect. The courses are targeted to those who want to start learning Arabic, make progress or strengthen their spoken Arabic. There are also initial and intermediate courses for children, from age 3 to 5 and from 6 to 12. This year two Arabic courses are also offered in English.

Formats

Intensive courses – 60 hours/month, morning or evening (3 hours of class plus a break of 30 minutes).

Semiintensive courses – 30 hours/month, morning or evening (2,5 hours of class plus a break of 15 minutes), 16 hours/month for some conversation courses.

Teachers

Native-speaker teachers from the Arabic Language Centre with over 10 years of experience Teaching Arabic as a Foreign Language.

How to enroll:

Online enrolment, via Casa Árabe/Arabic Language Centre (casaarabe.es) website, with credit card or bank transfer

If payment is to be done by bank transfer or in cash at the bank, the payment should be deposited in the following La Caixa account:

name and surname + course code (ej. LUZ DÍAZ AMEIN I 1).

Once the payment is made, scan the bank receipt, go to the website and follow the enrolment instructions.

Certification

Courses end with a final exam and, if passed, a progress certificate is given. Conversation courses do not have a final exam and so only an attendance certificate is given.

Moreover

Enrolment gives access to the student's private area (student records, resources, program, etc.), discounts for cinema, Balqís bookshop and Shukran restaurant of Casa Árabe and a reduced fee for enrolment in Arabic courses for school year 2019-20.

AME I B: for people who know the basic letters, sounds, reading and basic grammar of initial level.

AMEIN I = AME I A + AME I B

CONAME I D: level A1.1 according to CEFR needed (or have taken AME I A, B and C)

CONAME II D: level A1.2 according to CEFR needed (or have taken AME II A, B and C)

CONAME III D: level A2.1 according to CEFR needed (or have taken AME III A, B and C)

CONAME IV D: level A2.2 according to CEFR needed (or have taken AME IV A, B and C)

CONAME V D: level B1.1 according to CEFR needed (or have taken AME V A, B and C)
